

RULES FOR THE TREASURE HUNT “ Genoa: City of art, History and Sea”

1. On occasion of the arrival of the “Tall Ships Races” the Lions District 108 Ia2 is organizing a treasure hunt for charity to be held in the historic centre of Genoa on July 28th 2007. The funds thus raised will be entirely donated to the “**Research on rare diseases in children**” (Institute G.Gaslini).
2. The Treasure Hunt is open to all Italian citizens, to visitors from abroad and to the crews of the Tall Ships against payment of a registration fee.
3. The official language of the event is Italian. The rules and the questions attaining to the Treasure Hunt have been translated into English for a better understanding by those who have no confidence with the Italian language.
4. All participants will receive a pleasant give away on behalf of *MSC cruises*.
5. Participation in the Treasure Hunt is permitted after registration by means of the specific form supplied by the organization.
6. Inscription may be carried out on **July 28 2007** from **9 a.m. to 4 p.m.** at the Secretariat of the treasure hunt at the **Museo del Mare in Genoa**.
7. The registration fee for the treasure hunt is **€50,00** per team.
8. Each team may be made up from 1 to 5 persons maximum, and at least one member must be of age. A captain must be named and a mobile phone cell number (if available) given at time of registration. Each team will receive a number in progression in order of registration from the information office of the organization of the treasure hunt .
9. On inscription all teams must sign this regulation form, the surety form , the form of consent for treatment of personal data and give permission for use of videos and/or photographs.
10. Lack of cognizance of the present regulation on behalf of the players cannot be cited as a reason for the non-application of the regulation itself.
11. Each participant must keep a correct behaviour during the game-hunt and be respectful of his/her team-mates, members of other teams, sites visited and all encountered during the hunt. The organization of the treasure hunt may , at its' discretion, inflict a penalty on those who break these rules, up to disqualifying them from the game.
12. Only **100** teams may take part in the game, proceeding in order of inscription.

13. Each registered team must present itself at **4,30 p.m.** (16,30) **July 28, 2007** for credit at the secretariat of the treasure hunt at the Museo del Mare of Genoa, exhibiting the identification badge received at time of registration. At the **START** at **5 p.m.** (17,00), each team will receive the first envelope for the beginning of the treasure hunt. The treasure hunt will unravel through the historic centre of Genoa and the questions will regard the city of Genoa, life at sea, ships and the Seafaring Italian Republics .
14. Each team may make use of N° 3 optional hints to be given by the organization against payment of €20,00 (1st.hint), € 35,00 (2nd. Hint) and €50,00 (3rd. hint). The hints may be requested only by the captain at the stations of the organization placed along the route (easily identifiable by the Lions logogram) and their use will be marked on his/her identification badge.
15. The same questions will be made to all teams. As each question is gotten through, the team's time will be registered by a member of the organization who will give out the next envelope with the question that follows. The hunt will be won by the team who on arriving for first before **21,00 (9 p.m.) on July 28, 2007** will deliver all the envelopes on the last leg of the treasure hunt. The prizes will be awarded to the first five teams who correctly qualify for receiving them. Prize-giving will take place at **21,30 (9,30 p.m.) on July 28, 2007** on board the **Training Ship Amerigo Vespucci**.
16. The Start of the Treasure Hunt will begin with the giving-out of the first envelope at **17,00 (5 p.m) on July 28, 2007** at the Museo del Mare in Genoa and will end with the solution of the last question within and not after **21,00 (9 p.m.) on the same day**.
17. It is forbidden for all participants to make use of private means of transport such as cars/ motorbikes/bicycles etc. but public means of transport such as buses, lifts, funiculars, ferries etc. may be used.
18. The organization reserves itself the right to annul the treasure hunt at any moment and for any reason should it deem the hunt no longer feasible or able to be carried on, without having to refund other than the inscription fee. Those, be they a team or a single member of the same, who do not present themselves within 17,30 (5,50 p.m.), will be considered renouncers and have no right to reimbursement.
19. The treasure hunt is organized by the Lions District 108 Ia2 . The effective functioning during the hunt is assured by members of the organization who can be easily recognised of special identification badges.

20. All participants must have the utmost sporting fairness and respect for persons and belongings whether they are involved in the hunt or not.
21. All participants must abide by the current norms and laws of the Criminal and Civil Code . Sanctions inflicted for the breaching of the above are debited to the participant only.
22. The Lions District 108 Ia2 may in no way be retained responsible for damages caused, even if accidentally, to people or things by those participating in the treasure hunt.
23. The Lions District 108 Ia2 may in no way be retained responsible for any damages occurring to participants or their belongings.

All controversies arising will be dealt by the Court of Genoa.

Information for the treatment of personal data:

The Italian law Decree N°.196 of 30th June, 2003 (law for the treatment of personal data) provides that the treatment of the collected personal data (i.e. data related to individuals and companies) has to be performed in a correct, transparent and lawful manner. The handling of data will be carried out as to guarantee that the correct legislative norm is enforced.

Each competitor must fill in and sign the inscription form of the Treasure Hunt . In the case of minors, the form must be signed by a parent or a liable adult. In regard to the crews of the Tall Ships, should there be minors, signature of the competitor and the name of the Ship on which he/she is embarked will suffice.

The undersigned declares to have read and accepted all the norms for the treatment of personal data and the Rules of the Treasure Hunt. The Lions District 108 Ia2 is thereby indemnified from all civil or penal responsibilities as stated in Regulation form herewith enclosed and from compensation for whatever damage may arise to persons and things during the Hunt.
